In the part of the play we have read, Kreon finds out that Antigone is the one that had buried her brother when he was not supposed to be buried. In Kreon's point of view he thinks that she should be killed for such a terrible crime. She thinks that she did no crime and that her brother was a good person who never hurt anyone. Antigone's sister Ismene said that she was also involved when she wasn't because she wanted to die with her sister. Kreon says—"this girl is guilty of double impertinence: breaking the law and then boasting of it! If this crime goes unpunished, and she's the victor, who's the man then? she or I." This means that he thinks that if he doesn't punish her she is the real man in the situation and she didn't only commit the crime she also was very proud of it which just adds on to the crime.

He thinks that she doesn't care about her other brother and she is the only one who cares about the bad brother who everyone hates. The sentry was said to have been paid by someone to get through to bury the brother but he had nothing to do with it and his life was saved while Antigone's was still on the line. He wants to kill Antigone and she thinks that she just did what her brother would like to happen when he died, to be buried. She believes that "her nature is to love, not to hate". And that is where she and Kreon don't agree because he thinks that her brother is scum and that was why he was not buried by the government.
